A Commitment to Excellence and Faith

As of March 2025, Trinity Home Educators Co-Op will implement two essential policy updates that align with standard practices across all educational co-ops. These changes are designed to enhance the educational experience and ensure a commitment to both academic and spiritual growth.

Year-Long Commitment to Learning

Courses marked with an asterisk (*) and labeled as (YL) or describe as year-long in the description and requires a year-long commitment which the course cannot be dropped after registration. This is a shared practice among educational co-ops to emphasize the importance of consistency and dedication in the learning journey. Before registering, we encourage all parents to thoroughly research the course materials to ensure they align with your student's learning style. Review the textbook online and read the course description carefully, paying attention to the workload and time requirements outside of class. If you have any questions or need further clarification, please do not hesitate to reach out to the instructor for guidance.

The Essence of Community and Consistency

Our instructors passionately design their courses with the understanding that they are crafting a year-long educational journey for your students. Building strong relationships with our students allows us to tailor our teaching to meet them where they are. Once a class reaches the minimum enrollment of five students, it becomes a vibrant space for enriching discussions and active exploration. Cancelled enrollments disrupt this balance, impacting both the remaining students and the teacher.
